We began this work in 1912 with one student and no money. We have now a property and endowment of \$995,000, and 397 students.

Due to unforeseen economic conditions many students could not pay full tuition this year. This, together with a cut of \$5,000 by the Board of National Missions from their allowance to us, is bringing us to the close of our year, December 1927, with a balance of \$10,000 needed to pay the necessary expenses incurred to carry our students through the year.
