Dear Ed:

I have written Mr. Samuel P. S. Newton of Merrill, Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Beane, 70 Pine Street, New York City, notifying him of his nomination as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Polytechnic Institute of Puerto Rico in the Class of 1950, and I have sent him a copy of the latest catalogue of the Institute. I told him I was leaving tonight for St. Louis, to be gone a week, but upon my return I would call upon him and talk with him about the work of the Board. I also told him that you were in the city and I was suggesting that you try to see him before you get away. I told him you were pretty well tied up and might not be able to get to see him but I was sure that you would if you could. I think it would help very much if you could see Mr. Newton and hope you can arrange it. I would suggest you telephone him first - Whitehall 4-1212 - and make an appointment. I realize you may have to be out of the city contacting future teachers for the Institute and may not be able to work this in, but I know that you will if you can.

I thought we had a fine meeting of the Board yesterday afternoon. Several members of the Board expressed themselves to me likewise. Your report was splendid. I will follow through on the matter of the committee of Trustees to visit the Institute. Duncan Findlay expects to be able to take the trip but may not be able to get away until May. I will take the matter up with Fifield Workum when I know Mr. Findlay's plans. Roswell Miller is to be in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the month of March, and stated he would try to fly over to Puerto Rico some time during that month. If you wish to get in touch with him, address him in care of General Delivery, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

The Annual Report has been completed and is being held in my office. Will you stop in for it?
