- High School diploma from Poly - in 1924.
- attended Temple University from 1924 to 1926.
- attended Pace Institute, New York, and graduated in 1928.
- Diploma of accounting and Business Administration.
- 1931-1937 - Comptroller Puerto Rico, Guayama, P.R.
- 1935 - passed the examinations of the American Institute of Accountants and became a member of that organization as well as of the Puerto Rican Institute of Accountants.
- 1937-1941 - attended University of Virginia, at Charlottesville, Va., where I received my M. A. degree in 1941.
- 1942-1946 - practiced law and accounting in San Juan, P.R.
- 1946-1949 - President, Tax Court of Puerto Rico.
- 1945-1946 - Member, Public Service Commission of P.R.
